The purpose of the Alice Freeman Reed Scholarship Fund is to provide a needs-based award to undergraduate students at the University of New Hampshire who major in Human Development and Family Studies. To be eligible for the award:

1. Applicants must be in their freshman, sophomore, or junior year of their undergraduate studies.
2. Applicants must be first-in-family college students.

Awardees may receive up to \$2,000, and must remain enrolled as Human Development and Family Studies students during the year they receive the funding. If a student transfers out of the Human Development and Family Studies major in the year they receive the scholarship, the award will be withdrawn. Previous awardees may reapply for the scholarship.
