

Exercise Science B.S. - Application for Internal Transfer

Policy

Available space in the Exercise Science major for internal transfer students varies each year and is dependent on the number of admitted freshmen, number of transfers into and out of the program, and the number of qualified students at the time of application.

Students are eligible to apply to the major if they have a UNH GPA of at least 3.0 and have taken BMS 507 Human Anatomy and Physiology I and one additional major required course (see list below) and earned a grade of C or better in each. Applications are evaluated twice annually with June 7 and January 7 submission deadlines for admittance the following semester.

Students should review the suggested course sequence in the 4-year degree plan found on the Exercise Science website, and consider sequencing of prerequisite courses to determine what year of the program they will join. Transfer students may require additional time for degree completion. Students must also read, and if admitted to the major sign, the Pre-Professional Health Policy and Standards for Continuing in the Exercise Science Major documents available on the website.

Transfer into the Exercise Major is dependent on the space available in the major at the time of application and the following criteria: GPA, grades in BMS 507 and other major classes, and your letter of interest. Admission decisions are made by the Exercise Science Faculty and all decisions are final.

Procedure

Your complete application should be **emailed** to <u>Aurora.Vellante@unh.edu</u>, Exercise Science Major Coordinator, <u>as a</u> <u>single .PDF file</u> that includes 1) checklist with signature, 2) letter of interest, 3) DegreeWorks grade report. <u>Paper</u> <u>copies will not be accepted</u>. Applications submitted after one of the deadlines will be evaluated during the next admission cycle. Failure to submit any required information will invalidate the application. Applicants will receive an emailed letter of acceptance or denial from the Major Coordinator within three weeks after the deadline.

Requirements for Application

- 1. Minimum UNH GPA of 3.00
- 2. Completion of **BMS 507 and <u>one other</u> Exercise Science major required course** (taken at UNH) from the following list with a grade of C or better:
 - a. Examples include: BMS 508, EXSC 520, EXSC 620, NUTR 400, CHEM 403, CHEM 404, PSYC 401, PSYC 402
- 3. Letter of Interest In 1,000 words or less discuss:
 - a. Why you want to get a degree in Exercise Science and the careers you are considering.
 - b. Your academic background and preparedness to succeed in a rigorous science-based program.
 - c. The personal attributes and experiences that make you a strong candidate.
- 4. Grade Report
 - a. Include a screenshot of all your "Class History" in DegreeWorks. This can be found by clicking the 3 dots in the right header of DegreeWorks. Be sure to include the current semester and courses currently registered for in the upcoming semester. This is the chronological, semester-by-semester, grade record, not the degree worksheet. You should wait to submit your application until the final semester grades are posted to DegreeWorks.
 - b. If you have any courses you transferred from another university that are not captured in the Class History include an image of the transcript from that college or university.

5. Checklist

- a. Populate the GPA and required major course grade sections
- b. Assure you meet application requirements and check each box
- c. Sign the application
